	The play-off will cease once the qualifying spot(s) has been determined. Alternate spots will be decided by card count-back over the last 9, 6, 3, 1 hole(s) (holes $10 - 18$) and, if still tied, by card match play from the first hole on the scorecard. Any results achieved in the play-off for the final qualifying spot will supersede the card count back. Example: In a 5-man play-off for the last qualifying spot, the results on the first play-off hole are: Player A - 3, Players B & C - 4, Players D & E - 5. Player A would get the last qualifying spot, Players B & C would be ranked 1st and 2nd alternates in accordance with their card count back.		
	Successful qualifiers who withdraw from the Tournament will be replaced by the first alternate up until 17:00 h local time, two days prior to the Tournament 1st round. After this date, all withdrawals will be replaced by the Challenge Tour Tournament first reserve onsite.
